Applications are reviewed and students are accepted on a rolling basis. Students are expected to pay the \$300 deposit within one week of acceptance.

Course Description

This Travel Course will take students to the Portuguese archipelago of the Azores, an autonomous region of Portugal. Azores is known for its exquisite eco-friendly beauty and rich religious and cultural traditions. Students will attend language and culture classes at the University of the Azores. While there, students will be fully immersed in the language and culture of the region, Students will be able to interact with local Azoreans and are expected to engage in daily conversational classes, Students are also going to be able to connect with the Azorean communities in places such as in New Bedford, where immigrant communities thrive and continue to maintain their cultural values.

Sites & Highlights

Some of the activities for the course include sharing traditional Azorean food, a visit to the local outdoor market, a trip to a volcanic site, Lagoa do Fogo & Ribeira Grande, and visiting the University of Azores,
