#### **Course Description**

Barcelona, a capital of Catalonia in Spain, has been an inspiration for many artists and writers who have admired an amazing amalgamation of the Gothic and Modernist elements in its architecture, its breath-taking locale on the mountains overlooking the Mediterranean, its colorful multilingual history, and an outstanding regional cuisine.
