## THE SCHOOL:

- Placed in the town of Cumbaya, a suburb of Quito
- Grade level: Preschool through 12th grade
- Students will teach for 8 weeks



## LOCATION:

- Quito is the capitol of Ecuador, South America
- Central Square is located 16 miles south of the equator – Cumbaya is east of the central square
- Cumbaya is home to Universidad San Francisco de Quito – BSU has an exchange partnership with USFQ – first private and nondenominational university in Ecuador





## REQUIREMENTS:

1. All MTELs should be passed or pending.
2. Students should meet all of their department's and CEAS student teaching requirements.
3. Apply online through the Study Abroad Office website.
4. Meet with the CEAS liaison to Study Abroad, Dr. Robert MacMillan

## ACCOMMODATIONS:

- Students will reside with host families—teachers or parents of students attending Colegio Manor
- Private room
- Housing cost will go directly to the host families
- Meals and laundry included
