

# STUDENT TEACH IN BELIZE!

## THE SCHOOL:

- Local school on Ambergris Caye Island and Caye Caulker
- Students will assist teachers, support classroom environments and teach
- Student Teachers will teach for 8 weeks



## LOCATION:

- Belize is the only country in Central America that has English as the official language.
- The climate is tropical and Belize is home to the second largest barrier reef in the world.
- Student teaching will take place on Ambergris Caye, located off the coast of Belize in the Caribbean Sea, northeast of Belize City. Or, on Caye Caulker, an island South of San Pedro.



## REQUIREMENTS:

1. All MTEs should be passed or pending.
2. Students should meet all of their department's and CEAS student teaching requirements.
3. Apply online through the Study Abroad Office website.
4. Meet with the CEAS liaison to Study Abroad, Dr. Robert MacMillan
5. Upon acceptance, enrollment materials will be distributed. Students will need to obtain medical certificates, background checks, and official transcripts to submit to Ministry of Education in Belize.



## ACCOMMODATIONS:

- Typically an apartment rented on a short term basis, 8 weeks.
- Housing costs will vary depending on the semester, due to the high and low tourist seasons, and the number of BSU students renting an apartment.
- Students should expect to pay a security deposit to the property owner as well as utilities including electricity, water, cable and internet.



## MEALS:

- Apartment includes a kitchen
- Students will arrange meals on their own
