

BSU International Student Teaching

"International student teaching is the vehicle to transport students to different places and different challenges – in and out of the classroom."

There are many opportunities to engage in an International student teaching (IST) experience at Bridgewater State University. This is a one quarter (seven-eight weeks), six credit experience. The student teacher will do their first quarter home in Massachusetts, their second quarter abroad. All instruction on site is in English. Participants will be selected by representatives of the College of Education and Health Sciences. Over 10% of BSU student teachers go aboard each semester! We will have had 289 students go abroad for IST as of May 2020! We are exploring future sites in Tokyo, Tbilisi, Georgia, Namburu, India, Cartagena, Columbia, and Canterbury, England.

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Manchester, England

Teach in West Didsbury Schools, N-5th grades. Be immersed in the culture living with a host family. Experience is coordinated with Manchester Metropolitan University. Estimated cost: \$3,660

Quito, Ecuador

Teach at Colegio Menor, a N-12 international school and be immersed in the culture living with a host family. Estimated cost: \$2,550

Hong Kong, China

Teach at an on-campus local early childhood center or elementary school at the Education University of Hong Kong (EUHK). Housing at EUHK. Estimated cost: \$3,145

Ambergris Caye (San Pedro) or Caye Caulker, Belize

Teach in local schools (in San Pedro N-12, or on Caye Caulker, Prek-8); live in an apartment. Experience coordinated with Belize Ministry of Education. Estimated cost: \$3,310-3,510

Dublin, Ireland

Teach in local Irish schools (grades PreK-6, secondary school). Experience is coordinated with the Marino Institute of Education. Estimated cost: \$3,685

Shanghai, China

In Shanghai, teach at Jinshan School (grades k-12), live on campus. Estimated cost: \$1800 (includes housing and meals)

Zurich, Switzerland

Teach in local schools (Prek-6; high school English); immersed in the culture living with a host family. Experience is coordinated with Zurich University of Teacher Education. Estimated cost: \$2,950



Scholarships/internships are available to support candidates.
