Rolling Acceptance

Applications are reviewed and students are accepted on a rolling basis. Students are expected to pay the \$300 deposit within one week of acceptance.

Course Description

Students will participate in a 2-week firsthand experience in the country of Georgia. During the first week of the trip, participants will co-teach with a Georgian teacher at Buckswood International School during their summer school program for English language learners. During the second week of the trip, the group will travel north to Kazbegi and west to Batumi and the Black Sea. During predeparture meetings, participants will research and present key features of Georgian culture, including religion, geographical location, current and historical connections to neighboring countries, food traditions and/or education

Sites and Highlights

Will include experiences in Old Tbilisi, Mtskheta, Kazbegi National Park, Vardzia, Kutaisi, Batumi, and the Black Sea.
