Applications are reviewed and students are accepted on a rolling basis. Students are expected to pay the \$300 deposit within one week of acceptance.

Course Description

Canada is a vast country made up of very diverse cultural aspects. This course will explore western Canada in particular, focusing on 3 subject areas: dinosaurs, cowboy culture, and WWII internment camps. This course will link these diverse areas through the practice of travel writing. Students will be introduced to the genre, and will develop a series of travel pieces. This writing will be shared on student-produced travel blogs, and will also incorporate social media strategies.

Sites and Highlights

Highlights include the Royal Tyrell Museum, Dinosaur Provincial Park, a visit to the Badlands, Calgary Heritage Park, Visits to Alberta and British Columbia, Sunshine Valley Tashme Museum, Japanese Canadian National Museum & Cultural Center, and Jasper Wilderness Hike.
